A grand opening of the show with refreshments took place on Tuesday, April 22... The exhibition featured 60 selections of outstanding student-originated visual arts in a variety of media... Prizes were awarded by a jury of professional artists and arts administrators coordinated through CAW Executive Director Susan Smith.

Diversity "Dream Teams"

Breaking Barriers, Building Bridges

Under the direction of Dave Maloney and in partnership with the Anti-Defamation League, the SCC Diversity Dream Teams - Breaking Barriers, Building Bridges – had another successful year... The program held its final session of the 2007-08 academic year on May 16 at the Jewish Community Center in Woodbridge... Over 125 students representing the 23 member schools participated in the year-long program.

14th Annual Scholar Leader Banquet

The 14th annual SCC Scholar Leader Banquet was held on March 24 at Anthony's Ocean View in New Haven... Forty-four students representing 22 SCC member schools were recognized for their outstanding scholarship and leadership in their respective school communities... In addition, Catherine Cheng (Cheshire) and Erin Casey (North Haven) were recognized as the recipients of the "Bill O'Brien Community Service Scholarship"... Catherine and Erin, who each received \$500, were chosen by a committee composed of the the league's corporate sponsors... Criteria, which included a submitted 500-word essay, included having a healthy balance of school and community activities that are value-added and embody the "spirit and passion" of Bill O'Brien, the league's Commissioner Emeritus.

SCC State Championships

It was another successful year on the playing fields for the SCC as member schools fared well in the various league and state-wide competitions... All told, SCC teams captured 11 state championships (3 fall, 5 winter, 3 spring) during the 2007-08 academic year... Seventeen additional teams (5 fall, 9 winter, 3 spring) earned runner-up status in CIAC state competition... Since the league's inception in 1994, SCC schools have won 263 state championships... **See page seven for complete list of 2007-08 state championships.**

Did You Know?

In the 14 years of the SCC, Cheshire has won the most state titles of any member school (48) followed by Hillhouse (38), Amity (26) and Fairfield Prep (21). Hand is next with 18 while Branford and Guilford each have won 17 state titles.

SCC Year in Review - cont.

Qualifying for the CIAC Postseason

FALL: Forty-six out of a possible 68 teams qualified for CIAC fall sport playoff competition in girls soccer (13-of-18), boys soccer (15-of-20), girls volleyball (12-of-19), and field hockey (6-of-11).

WINTER: During the winter sports season, 42 SCC teams (out of 57 eligible teams) qualified for CIAC playoff competition in girls basketball (14-of-20), boys basketball (15-of-21), and ice hockey (13-of-16).

SPRING: Fifty-seven SCC teams (out of a possible 87) qualified for CIAC spring sport team playoff competition in 2007: *baseball* (15-of-21), *softball* (14-of-20), *boys lacrosse* (9-of-13), *girls lacrosse* (5-of-10), *boys volleyball* (4-of-5) and *golf* (10-of-19).

The Best of the Best!

You can make a very good argument for the overall strength of the SCC when you look at the final state rankings of pretty much every sport... However, to have the "best team" is even more impressive and the SCC has the top team in the state in girls basketball and ice hockey...

Career Tops in Girls Basketball

Career, under the direction of head coach Kevin Walton, finished as the top girls basketball team in the final state polls (*New Haven Register and Hartford Courant*)... The Panthers (26-2), who won the 2008 Oronoque Division and SCC Tournament titles, captured the Class LL state championship with a hard-fought 71-66 victory over New Britain at CCSU's Detrick Gymnasium... Mercy (21-4) also finished in the top ten, while Hillhouse (16-8) and Wilbur Cross (18-9) also received votes.

Fairfield Prep Ice Hockey Back on Top

For the second straight season, Fairfield Prep finished as the top ice hockey team in the state... The Jesuits (13-10-1), who tied for second in the SCC Division I regular-season, captured the Division I state title with a 5-3 win over Notre Dame-Fairfield at Ingalls Rink... Other SCC teams finishing in the state's top ten polls included Hamden (17-4-1), SCC Division I regular-season champion East Haven (19-3), SCC and state Division II champion Amity (19-6-1), and Notre Dame-West Haven (11-9-1)... ***No other ice hockey league in the state had as many ranked teams as the SCC!***

SCC Hosts Unified Sports® Events

The SCC hosted two Unified Sports® events during the 2007-08 year... The league's first-ever event, a soccer tournament, was held on October 12 at Amity Regional High School...

Participating schools included Amity, Cheshire, West Haven, East Haven and Wilbur Cross... The New Haven Athletic Center was the site of the SCC Unified Sports Basketball Tournament on Monday, February 4... Ten SCC schools participated including Amity, West Haven, Wilbur Cross/Hillhouse, Hamden, Shelton, Jonathan Law, Lyman Hall, Cheshire and East Haven... Special thanks to Jon Capone (athletic director at West Haven High School) for coordination of the two events... Said SCC Commissioner Al Carbone, *"Unified Sports® is a program that fits nicely with our league's mission to offer positive opportunities for our students and we look forward to hosting more events in the future."*



West Haven and Branford Recognized for Unified Sports® Participation

Two SCC member schools - West Haven and Branford - were recognized by the CIAC for their outstanding participation in the CIAC/Special Olympics Unified Sports® program... West Haven earned a fourth-place award for the "Loving Cup" while Branford was recognized for its outstanding participation.

Amity Duo Earn Gatorade State Honors

Two SCC senior student-athletes from Amity Regional High School - **Janice Horn** (volleyball) and **Jason Esposito** (baseball) - were named the 2007-08 Gatorade High School Connecticut Players of the Year in their respective sports... Winners are selected not only for their outstanding athletic performance, but also for meeting high academic achievement standards while demonstrating exemplary personal character on and off the field.

Cheshire Girls Swimming Sets National Record

With a 112-66 victory over Branford on October 15, the Cheshire girls swimming team set the national record with its 235th consecutive dual-meet victory... Elkhart Central High in Indiana had won 234 in a row (1980-94)... Coincidentally, Cheshire beat Branford in the last meet of the regular season in 1986 to start the streak... The Rams, under the direction of head coach Ed Aston, proceeded to win its 14th consecutive SCC title a few weeks later.

On the Tube: MSG Televises SCC Contest

On Friday, September 28, the Shelton-Fairfield Prep football game was televised on MSG... It was the first time two SCC schools were showcased on the highly-popular regional sports network... In front of an enthusiastic crowd of 6,000, the Gaels nipped the Jesuits, 26-21... The game and telecast was deemed as "one of the best ever" by Mike Quick, MSG's high school sports director.

Basketball Tournaments Expand

The SCC boys and girls basketball tournaments expanded to include the four divisional winners plus any team that qualified for the CIAC state tournament (8 victories) up to a maximum of 16 teams... Fourteen teams qualified for the girls tournament with second-seeded Career defeating fourth-seeded Branford in the final... In the boys tournament, 15 teams earned a berth and top-seeded Wilbur Cross held off 14th-seeded Amity in the championship game... The Spartans did record upset victories over third-seeded Branford, sixth-seeded Hillhouse and seventh-seeded Career to earn their first championship game appearance.

Three Cheers for the Cheerleading Competition!!!

The SCC hosted another successful Cheerleading Competition on February 3, at Shelton High School... Twelve SCC schools participated in the competition in four different categories – 14-under squad size, 15-over squad size, co-ed and non-building.... Does The SCC Play The Best Baseball in the State?

Question: *What was the best high school baseball division in the state of Connecticut?* **Answer:** It could be the Hammonasset Division from the Southern Connecticut Conference... Four of the five teams in the Hammonasset Division reached the state semifinals in 2008... Three of the schools - Guilford, Hand and Jonathan Law - were in Class L, while Foran was in Class M... Jonathan Law, which defeated defending Class L champion and SCC-rival Guilford in the semifinals, won the state title - its first ever - with a 7-1 win over Fairfield Ludlowe on June 8 at Palmer Field... A fifth SCC school - Amity reached the Class LL semifinals for the sixth straight season before falling to eventual champion Westhill, 2-1... **Regardless, the SCC saw 71 percent (15-of-21) of its teams reach the CIAC playoffs and had a state-best seven teams reach the quarterfinal round and another state-best five reach the semifinals.**

Hillhouse's Ann Marie Clarke Named *New Haven Register* 2007-08 Female Athlete of the Year

Track & field standout Ann Marie Clarke (Hillhouse) was honored by the *New Haven Register* sports staff as the 2007-08 Female Athlete of the Year... Ann Marie, an All-SCC and All-State honoree in both indoor and outdoor track, was recognized at a banquet on June 26 at Amarante's Sea Cliff in New Haven... On her way to the University of Indiana with a full athletic scholarship, Ann Marie is the fifteenth SCC student-athlete who has been recognized with this prestigious honor.
