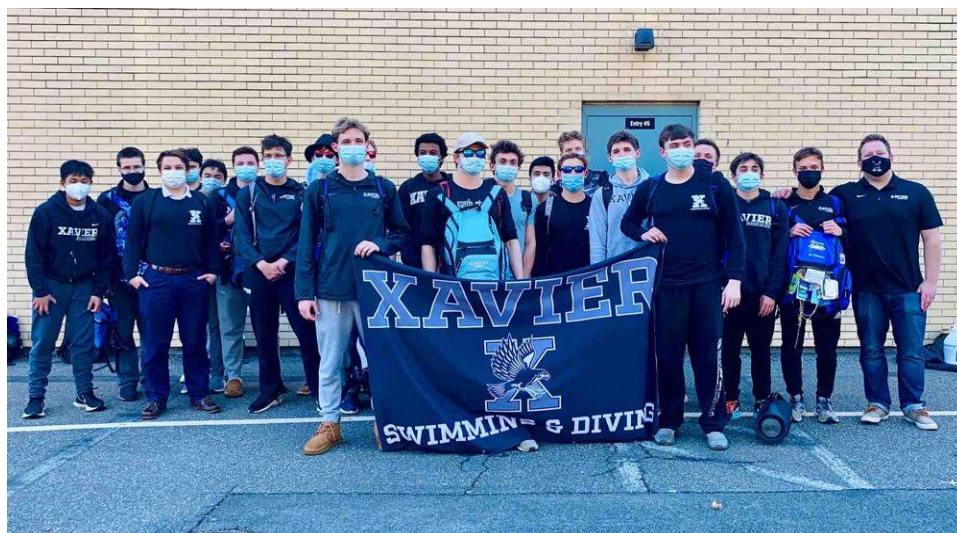


Xavier Claims Overall SCC Boys Swim and Dive Championship

The 2021 SCC Swim/Dive Championship Meet was held virtually from March 20-26, 2021, with each school competing in its own pool.

Led by four winning events, Xavier took home the 2021 title, scoring 974 points. Greater New Haven co-op, Fairfield Prep, Cheshire, and Hamden rounded out the top five.

Xavier was led by its first-place finishes in the 200 medley relay, 200 freestyle relay, 100 freestyle, and 100 backstroke events. Andrew Mitchell won the 100 free, while Mitchell Wollen touched the wall first in the 100 backstroke.

Finn Henry and Brendan Connors helped the co-op team of Greater-New Haven to its second-place showing. They won the 200 freestyle and 200 IM events respectively.

The lone dual-event winner was Joseph Zellner from Sheehan. He won the 50 freestyle and 100 breaststroke. He was named the Meet's Most Outstanding Swimmer.

Hamden's Jonah Heiser edged out Fairfield Prep's Thomas Kehoe in the diving portion (425.9 to 423.45 points).

Xavier also finished first among the Division 1 standings, while Hamden took home the Division II title.
